



AO VET NA Masters Course—Surgical Management of Injuries in Canine Sports Medicine with Wet-lab

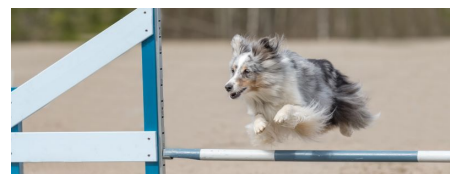

Canine sporting and working dog activities have become increasingly more popular over the past several decades. In turn, the demand for veterinarians skilled in Sports Medicine and Rehabilitation has increased – especially in the field of surgical management and recovery.

This masters-level course has been specifically designed for veterinary residents and veterinary surgeons to fine-tune their skills in the diagnosis and surgical treatment of sporting injuries to maximize success and allow for a return to athletic function in the canine patient. This newly formatted course includes pre-course lectures and case-based discussion to allow the LIVE event to focus on hands-on labs, small group discussions, and discussion of participant-provided cases.

Labs will utilize live dogs, cadaver specimens, and bone models to maximize learning of examination tips, musculoskeletal ultrasound, treatment of tendon & ligament injuries, fractures, and orthotics.
